Mr. Hasbrouck:

Consistent with our telephone conversation of March 29, attached is PG&E's reply to your protest of the above-referenced Advice Letter, which inadvertently, was not served upon you at the time it was submitted to the CPUC. Also, the CPUC's Energy Division has withdrawn without prejudice the disposition of the above-referenced Advice Letter, which inadvertently, was also not served upon you at the time of its issuance. Energy Division will take up the issue de novo, providing you 10 days so that you have time to receive and review the attached PG&E reply to your protest before issuing a disposition in this matter. We believe that these measures provide a procedural cure for CPUC Energy Division Staff's and PG&E's inadvertent errors.

We have also received your March 28 Request for Commission Review of the status and disposition of the above-referenced Advice Letter. Because we are withdrawing the March 19, 2012 Staff disposition in this matter, there is no longer an effective disposition. Therefore, we are holding this protest in abeyance. If after a disposition is issued you would like for the Commission to consider the March 28 Request for Commission Review, or an amended version of that Request, please feel free to re-file such Request during the period and in the manner allowed by the Commission's General Order 96-B and Rules of Practice and Procedure, both of which are available on our website at www.cpuc.ca.gov.

We apologize for our own inadvertent procedural error, and will review our internal processes for handling Advice Letters, and understand that PG&E will do the same. We also understand that PG&E has now served you with its response, but we are re-serving PG&E's reply in an abundance of caution. We regret any

inconvenience and frustration that these inadvertent procedural errors may have caused you. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions.
