

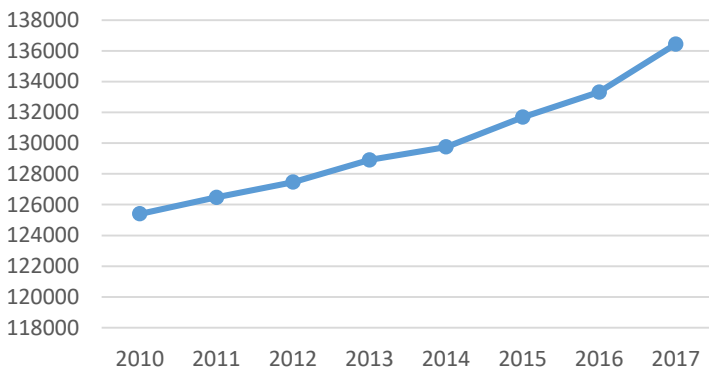


Waco, TX

- Demographics: 68.5% White, 21.0% African-American, 32.2% Hispanic, 2.0% Asian

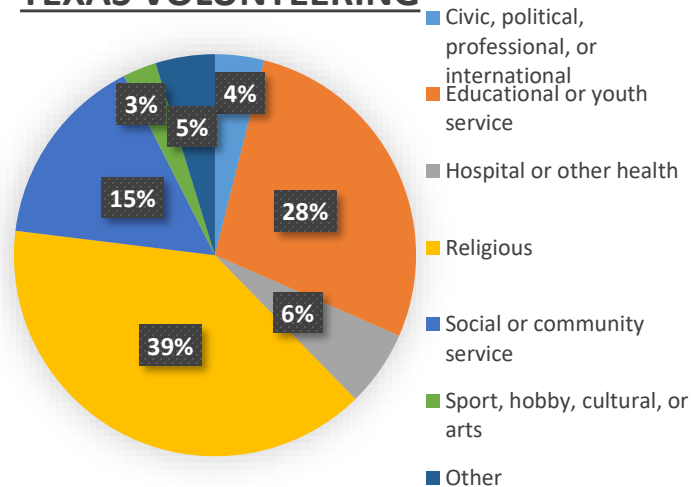
Waco Population

- **202,100** federal employees in Texas
- **3,100** federal employees in Waco
- **1.5m** veterans in TX, 6.0% of adult population
 - Approx. **7,626** Veterans in Waco
- **13,700** local government employees in Waco
- **2,700** state government employees in Waco
- **172,904** active duty/reserve at installations in Texas including:
 - Fort Hood
 - Joint Base San Antonio
 - Camp Mabry
 - Laughlin Air Force Base
