



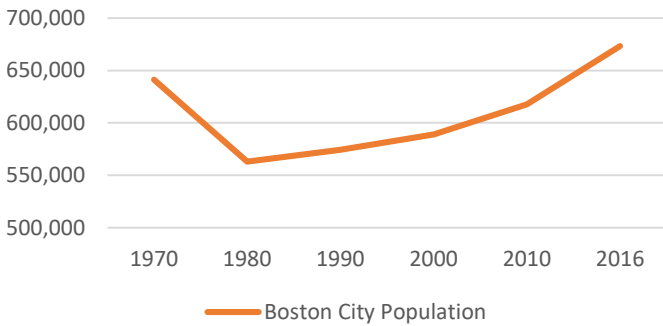
# Boston, MA



## POPULATION

- Nearly **675,000** in City
- More than **4,800,000** in Metro area
  - 10th largest US urbanized area
  - 9% pop. increase since 2010
- Third most densely populated large U.S. city
- Demographics: 45.3% White, 19.0% Hispanic, 25.4% African-American, 9.3% Asian, 4.9% two or more Races

## ECONOMICS

- Boston City Median Household Income: \$58,516
  - Greater Boston Area: \$82,380
  - Massachusetts: \$70,954
  - National: \$57,617
- 6<sup>th</sup> largest economy in USA, 12<sup>th</sup> largest in world
- Major economic activities include:
  - Higher education, high technology, tourism, financial services, printing/publishing
- Boston was the site of many US firsts:
  - Public school (1635)
  - Subway system (1897)
  - Public park (1634)

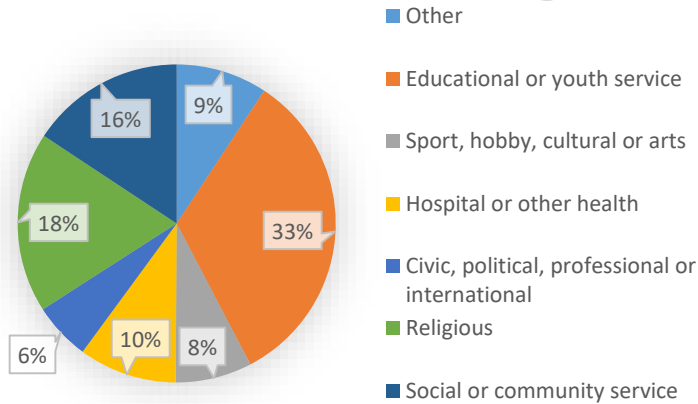
## FEDERAL & MILITARY PRESENCE
