

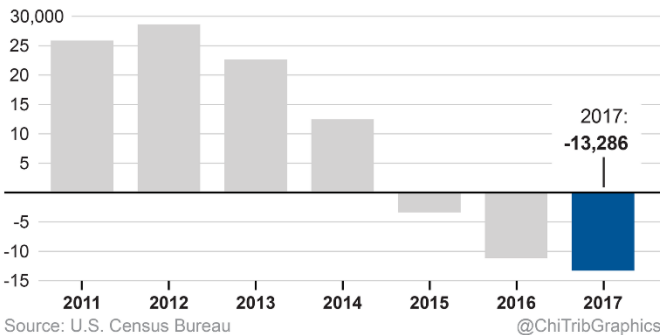


Chicago, IL

POPULATION

- City population: **2,716,450**
- Chicago MSA population: **9,512,968**
 - 3rd largest MSA in the US
 - Most populous city in Midwest US
- Demographics: 48.7% White, 30.9% African-American, 29.1% Hispanic, and 6.1% Asian

CHANGE IN CHICAGO POPULATION, BY YEAR



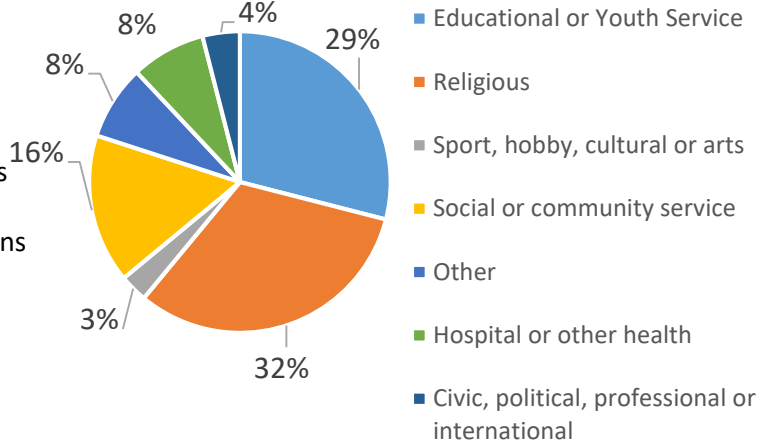
ECONOMICS

- Chicago Median Household Income: **\$50,434**
- Chicago MSA: \$63,327
 - Illinois: \$59,196
 - National: \$55,322
- Widely diversified economy, major economic sectors include manufacturing, printing and publishing, finance and insurance, and food processing
- Illinois is 2nd in the nation in Class I railroad coverage with over 7,000 miles of tracks
- Illinois is 3rd in the nation in transportation and warehousing with \$9.9 billion paid in employment

MILITARY & PUBLIC EMPLOYEE STATISTICS

- **78,700** federal employees in Illinois
- **53,500** federal employees in Chicago
- Approx. **802,000** veterans in Illinois
- **78,919** veterans in Chicago
- **447,700** Local, **57,400** State government employees in Chicago
- **20,038** active duty and **24,054** reserve at installations in Illinois including:
 - Naval Station Great Lakes, North Chicago
 - Haley Army Airfield
 - Scott Air Force Base
 - Camp Butler
 - Fort Massac
