

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE

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OFFERED BY MR. PERRY OF PENNSYLVANIA

At the end of subtitle B of title V of division A, insert the following:

1 SEC. 5_. REPEAL OF MILITARY SELECTIVE SERVICE ACT.

2 (a) REPEAL.—The Military Selective Service Act (50
3 U.S.C. 3801 et seq.) is repealed.

4 (b) TRANSFERS IN CONNECTION WITH REPEAL.—
5 Notwithstanding the proviso in section 10(a)(4) of the
6 Military Selective Service Act (50 U.S.C. 3809(a)(4)), the
7 Office of Selective Service Records shall not be reestab-
8 lished upon the repeal of such Act. Not later than 180
9 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the as-
10 sets, contracts, property, and records held by the Selective
11 Service System, and the unexpended balances of any ap-
12 propriations available to the Selective Service System,
13 shall be transferred to the Administrator of General Serv-
14 ices upon the repeal of the Military Selective Service Act.
15 The Director of the Office of Personnel Management shall
16 assist officers and employees of the Selective Service Sys-
17 tem to transfer to other positions in the executive branch.

1 (c) EFFECT ON EXISTING SANCTIONS.—Notwith-
2 standing any other provision of law, a person may not be
3 denied a right, privilege, benefit, or employment position
4 under Federal law on the grounds that the person, before
5 the repeal of the Military Selective Service Act (50 U.S.C.
6 3801 et seq.) by subsection (a), failed to present himself
7 for and submit to registration under section 3 of such Act
8 (50 U.S.C. 3802).
