This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act request, received in this office on December 28, 2021 requesting, "(1) *The most recent version of the Registrant Integrated Processing System (RIPS) Manual*; (2) *The most recent version of the Health Care Personnel Delivery System (HCPDS) Manual*; (3) *The most recent version of any proposed, contemplated, standby, or "contingency planning" changes or additions to or replacements for regulations of the Selective Service System, including but not limited to the regulations currently in 32 CFR Chapter XII and any regulations for the HCPDS*".
